

Silvergate Bank and Silvergate Capital Corporation (“Silvergate”) have adopted the following California Consumer Privacy Policy to explain how it collects, uses, and shares information from and about you in connection with certain of its products and services.

## California Consumer Rights

Beginning on January 1, 2020, the California Consumer Privacy Act of 2018 (CCPA) grants a consumer various rights with regard to personal information relating to that consumer that is held by a business.

“Personal information” means information that identifies, relates to, describes, is reasonably capable of being associated with, or could reasonably be linked, directly or indirectly, with a particular consumer or household. Personal information that is collected and subject to the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act or California Financial Information Privacy Act is exempt under the CCPA.

Individuals who are California residents have the rights outlined in this section pursuant to the CCPA. ### Access

You have the right to know and request certain information about our collection and use of your personal information over the past 12 months. We will provide you with the following information, as applicable:

- The categories of personal information that we have collected about you;
- The categories of sources from which that personal information was collected;
- The business or commercial purpose for collecting or selling your personal information;
- The categories of third parties with whom we have shared your personal information; and
- The specific pieces of personal information that we have collected about you.

If we have disclosed your personal information for a business purpose over the past 12 months, we will identify the categories of personal information shared with each category of third-party recipient.

We are prevented by law from providing the following:

- Your social security number;
- Driver’s license or other government-issued identification number;
- Financial account numbers;
- Any health insurance or medical identification number (if we have it); and
- Account passwords or security questions and answers.

## Deletion

You have the right to request that we delete the personal information that we have collected from you. Under the CCPA, the right is subject to certain exceptions; for example, we may need to retain your personal information to provide you with the services requested by you or complete a transaction you have requested, or to comply with our legal obligations. If your deletion request is subject to one of these exceptions, we may deny your deletion request.

## Opting Out

If a business sells personal information, a consumer has a right to opt out of the sale of their personal information.

## Exercising Your Rights

To exercise the rights described above, you must send us a request that: (1) provides information to allow us to verify that you are the person about whom we have collected personal information; and (2) describes your request in sufficient detail to allow us to understand, evaluate, and respond to it. We will use the information provided and may use transactional information to verify you and complete your request. You do not need an account to submit a request.

We will acknowledge your request within 10 business days. We will respond to your request within 45 days of receipt. If we are unable to respond within 45 days, we will inform you of such, provide an explanation, and respond within an additional 45 days.

You may also authorize an agent (“Authorized Agent”) to exercise your rights on your behalf. To do this, you must provide your Authorized Agent with written permission to do so, and we may request a copy of this written permission from your Authorized Agent when they make a request to exercise your rights on your behalf.

## We Will Not Discriminate Against You For Exercising Your Rights Under the CCPA

We will not discriminate against you for exercising your rights under the CCPA. We will not deny you our products or services, charge you different prices or rates, or provide you a lower quality of products and services if you exercise your rights under the CCPA.

## Personal Information Notice

Silvergate is committed to maintaining the privacy of your personal information. Consumer information that is collected and subject to the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act or California Financial Information Privacy Act is exempt under the CCPA. Other temporary exemptions apply, such as information from business-purpose communications.

California job applicants, current and former employees, and contractors have the right to know before information is collected, the categories of personal information we collect and the purpose. The following describes the personal information we collect and why.

**Sharing of Personal Information**

We do not disclose your personal information with third parties except as allowed by law. In the past 12 months, we have disclosed the categories of personal information, as permitted by law. We share information only with third parties to perform services on our behalf, such as maintaining and servicing your accounts, and performing audit-related tasks. We require that third parties not sell, share, or use your information for any other purpose.

We do not and will not sell your personal information. We will not sell the personal information of minors under the age of 16 without affirmative consent. We have not sold personal information in the past 12 months.

**Changes to This Policy**

Silvergate may update this policy. We will alert you to changes. The date of the last update, if any, will be reflected at the bottom of this policy. Use of information we collect is subject to the policy in effect at the time such information is collected.
